# **APPLICATION FOR DIV. 1 DIRECTOR SEAT AVAILABLE, DEADLINE APRIL 4**

*Palmdale, CA* – The Palmdale Water District (PWD) Board of Directors is accepting applications for the Division 1 Director position, which will be filled by appointment before the end of April.

Applicants must be registered voters and reside within the boundaries of Division 1, which roughly borders Avenue P to the north, Avenue R to the south, 35<sup>th</sup> Street to the east and Highway 14 to the west, and between 10<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Streets West from Avenue N on the north to Avenue O-12 on the south. The Board voted Monday not to change its five division boundaries as part of this year's redistricting.

To be considered for the position, the Division 1 Director Applicant Questionnaire must be filled out and submitted by April 4, 2022. The questionnaire and map of Division 1 are available online at <https://bit.ly/3q4sGLi>. It is also posted at PWD's main office at 2029 East

The Division 1 seat has been vacant since March 1 following the resignation of former Director Amberrose Merino. The appointee will serve until December 2024, the remainder of the vacated term.
