LEARN HOW TO CUSTOMIZE YOUR YARD AT PWD'S WATER- WISE WORKSHOP ON SEPT. 26

Palmdale, CA – Local landscape specialist Brad Hayes will share his expertise on using various landscape materials to spruce up your yard at Palmdale Water District's (PWD) Water-Wise Workshop: Customize Your Yard event.

The free workshop is scheduled for 5-6 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 26, at PWD's main office, 2029 East Avenue Q, Palmdale. There also will be a short presentation by the Antelope Valley Resource and Conservation District (AVRCD) highlighting its Lawn Rebate Program.

Together with the AVRCD’s Lawn Rebate Program, it’s a perfect workshop for those interested in converting their yards to drought-friendly landscapes.”

At the workshop, PWD staff will also offer information on how to apply for the Water-Wise Landscape Conversion Program, which gives residential customers up to \$3,000 in rebates and an unlimited amount for commercial accounts.

In 2022, PWD issued \$150,198 in rebates to customers for removing 84,507 square feet of landscape.
